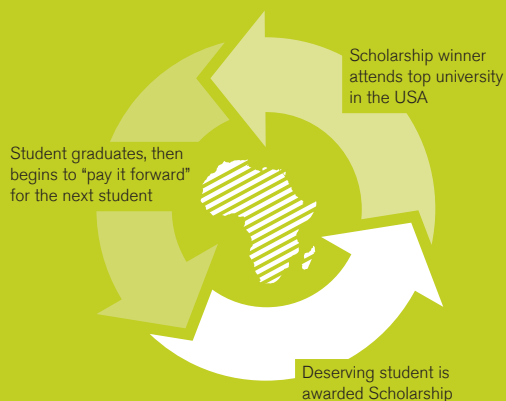


Pay It Forward
